Dear Member of Congress:

Immigration is a complex and highly politicized conversation in the United States. The principles of human rights – based on the inherent dignity of every person – provide a simple, straight-forward framework for how this country should treat those within its borders.

When considering immigration policy, I urge you to uphold the values upon which our freedom and democracy rest. Please protect the human rights of everyone within our borders, regardless of citizenship or immigration status. Hold the Department of Homeland Security accountable for its actions. Support immigration policies that work for our economy and our families and ensure the following:

- **Due Process** – guarantee everyone a fair day in court, ending mandatory deportation laws and restoring judicial review.
- **Freedom from Arbitrary Detention** – end mandatory detention laws that fail to take individual circumstances into account.
- **Respect for Family Unity** – allow judges to consider family ties when making decisions about deportation.
- **Refugee Protection** – recommit the United States to the protection of refugees and asylum seekers.
- **Worker Protection** – ensure that all workers in the United States enjoy safe and fair working conditions.
